Page 139—Lines 53 to 55/L; read:

Tanjung Pelepas (1°22'N., 103°33'E.) a new port in the SW part of Malaysia, lies about 8 miles W of Singapore, on the W side of Johor Strait at the mouth of Sungai Pilai.

Depths—Limitations.—The port is approached from a position in the Cross Traffic area on the Traffic Separation Scheme S of **Tanjung Piai** (1°15.9'N., 106°30.6'E.) and entered through a channel dredged to a depth of 14m. The channel is marked by lighted buoys, the center line of which is marked by leading lights.

There is a total of 2,160m of berthing space available with a depth of 15m alongside.

Pilotage.—Pilotage is compulsory within port limits, and is available 24 hours. Pilot boards about 2 miles SE of Tanjung Piai.

Anchorage.—There are two designated anchorage areas as shown on the chart. A prohibited anchorage has been designated within the port limit.
