Nesna (66°12'N., 13°01'E.) is a small town with several light industries. Located at the end of a peninsula extending from the mainland, it is E of the island of Hugla, and S of the island of Handnesoya. Nesna has a concrete jetty, which has a NNE/SSW orientation. It is 117m long and has depths of 6.5 to 8.1m alongside. At the head of the jetty, a berth, orientated ESE/WNW, also of concrete construction, is 66m long and has depths of 3.9 to 7.1m alongside. Both jetty and berth protect a ferry and boat harbor on the N side of town.
