2. PIRATE ACTIVITY OFF THE EAST COAST OF SOMALIA HAS ESCALATED. MORE PIRACY ATTACKS HAVE OCCURRED AND SOME HAVE PROLONGED FOR SEVERAL HOURS MORE THAN 400 MILES OFF THE EAST COAST OF SOMALIA. VESSEL MASTERS ARE STRONGLY ADVISED TO REMAIN EAST OF 60E AND AT LEAST 600 MILES OFF THE COAST OF SOMALIA (REF. MARAD ADVISORY 2009-04).
3. U.S. FLAG VESSELS SHOULD PROVIDE TWO WEEKS ADVANCED NOTICE OF ARRIVAL TO THE WATERS OFF THE HORN OF AFRICA TO MARLO BAHRAIN. MORE ADVANCED NOTICE PROVIDES NAVAL FORCES MORE TIME TO PLAN THE USE OF AVAILABLE NAVAL ASSETS.
4. VESSELS ARE ADVISED TO CHECK IN WITH MARLO BAHRAIN AT LEAST 96 HOURS PRIOR TO ENTERING THE INTERNATIONALLY RECOMMENDED TRANSIT CORRIDOR (REF. MARAD ADVISORY 2009-04) THROUGH THE GULF OF ADEN. CHECK IN AGAIN UPON ENTERING THE CORRIDOR AND CHECK OUT UPON EXITING THE CORRIDOR.
