Chapter 12—Paragraphs 65 to 66; read:

⁽⁶⁵⁾ **Tarrytown**, Mile 24E, has about 1 mile of developed waterfront, part of which has been improved by dredging. **Tarrytown Light** (41°05'03"N., 73°52'28"W.), 54 feet above the water, is shown from a white cast iron and concrete tower.

⁽⁶⁶⁾ A Federal project provides for depths of 12 feet in both the northwest and southwest connecting channels in Tarrytown Harbor and also in the waterfront channel. (See Notice to Mariners and latest edition of the chart for controlling depths.) An obstruction, consisting of rocks, is on the east edge of the waterfront channel in about 41°04'48"N., 73°52'10"W. Both access channels are buoyed.

Chapter 2—Paragraphs 3330 to 3330.05; read:

⁽³³³⁰⁾ **§165.840 Regulated Navigation Area, Gulf of Mexico: Mississippi Canyon Block 20, South of New Orleans, LA.**

^(3330.01) (a) Effective date. This section is effective on April 4, 2013.

^(3330.02) (b) Location. The following area is a Regulated Navigation Area: A 300-foot diameter area at the water surface centered on the following coordinates: 28°52'17"N, 089°10'50"W, and extending the entire water column from the surface to the seabed.

^(3330.03) (c) Regulations.

^(3330.04) (1) In accordance with the general regulations in §165.13 of this part, all vessels are prohibited from anchoring, mooring or loitering in the above described area except as authorized by the Captain of the Port, New Orleans.

^(3330.05) (2) Persons or vessels requiring deviations from this rule must request permission from the Captain of the Port New Orleans. The Captain of the Port New Orleans may be contacted by telephone at 504-365-2200.

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
